

## National Corvette Museum FAQ

The August event has been expanded to include a ½ day of practice on Friday the 14th. We will be limiting Friday Practice to 100 drivers. Those that have entered a prior DKC event in 2015 will get a guaranteed spot.

Gates open beginning at 9 a.m. on Friday August 14th and close at 10 p.m. that day. Gate hours throughout the rest of the weekend will be from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. No trailers can exit the premises after 7 p.m. without approval from NCM management. 24 hour access will be available for those already staying at the track.

The track can be reached by exiting I-65 at exit 28. Take a left onto Corvette Dr. and drive past the Museum to Porter Pike. Turn left, go back under I-65 and then take a left onto Grimes Rd.

Garages can be rented for the event by contacting Sydney at 270-777-4509 or [Sydney@motorsportspark.org](mailto:Sydney@motorsportspark.org). Payments over the phone are accepted. There are a total of 3 Pro garages (17x50) for \$125 each and 18 Standard garages (17x25) for \$75 each. There is currently no compressed air in the garages. Parking for one trailer and tow vehicle as well as two additional vehicles is provided to renter.

Trailer landing pads and canopies shall have supporting wooden blocks to prevent damage to the pavement, NO exceptions. Please plan to provide your own materials to meet your own needs. You

Pit road is accessible to credentialed drivers and crew only. Please utilize the designated spectator areas or the observation deck to watch the event.

Fuel can be purchased by credit card at the track provided pumps. If you are bringing your own fuel, a maximum of 20 gallons in approved containers is allowed. No other fuel sales are allowed.

Fluid waste disposal will be provided at the facility. No spillage will be tolerated at the risk of ejection and/or penalties. This includes while refueling or working on a vehicle where a catch pan should be utilized. All environmental debris (tires, batteries, unwanted parts, etc.) must be removed from the facility by the participant.

Camping will be available at \$35 for a tent, \$50 for an RV. Electricity will be available on a first come, first served basis at \$25. Quiet hours for the entire facility is 10 p.m. to 7 a.m. with no race motors between 8 p.m. and 8 a.m. Additionally there will be a mandatory quiet hour on Sunday from 11:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. during the lunch break.

There are shower facilities and restrooms in the Pavilion Building in the paddock.

All ATV's, golf carts, mini-bikes and other off road vehicles must display a NCM provided license/permit at a cost of \$25. They are not to be used during hot track hours. License/permits are available in the Administration Building along with any additional information on restrictions.

Pets are discouraged, but will be allowed if leashed and cleaned up after. No pets on the false grid, or in any NCM buildings or concession areas.

No smoking in any NCM building or on pit lane. Place extinguished cigarettes in the receptacles provided.

Use of aerial drones is strictly prohibited.
